For example, the arrival of Christianity has depopulated the traditional religious customs in many tribal area of Northeast India. Besides these, globalization has affected the languages of the Northeastern tribes. Specially some 'Dowan' used by the tribes are in trouble because of the spread of foreign languages. Thus globalization stands as an effecting factor for the folk life of the Northeastern tribes.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is necessary to preserve the traditions or folk life of the Northeastern tribes. With this regard the following suggestions are provided.

- 1. Traditional cultures of the tribes of the region should be legally protected.
- Government should take initiatives relating to traditional culture and folk life of the tribal communities.
- 3. 'Heritage club' should be established.
- Public awarness programmes such as seminars, workshops etc. should be organized among the people.
- Government should take measures for the preservation of culture, muesum and traditions of the tribal communities.
- Food processing industries should be developed for the preservation of the traditional foods of the tribal communities of the region.

CONCLUSION

From the above discussion we may conclude that globalization has affected the traditions and cultures of the Northeastern tribes. As a result, the traditional life style of the Northeastern tribes are changing very quickly. But it is very complicated to make sure whether it is changing for better or worse.
